Dear St. Peter's Families,

As I mentioned in the newsletter last week, we are the very lucky winners of an exciting trip to London, to visit the V&A museum. This is an all-expenses paid trip and we hope as many children will attend as possible. The trip is available for all children in Key Stage 2. This means any child in years 3, 4, 5 or 6.

We will be leaving St. Peter's at 9am so it is essential that your child comes into school for 8.45am so that they can be registered before departure. We arrive at the museum in London at 11.30am where we will be provided with refreshments and will get to meet the museum's director; Tristram Hunt. From 12, the children will visit 'A Day at the Great Exhibition'; a special tour around the museum to discover what it would have been like to visit the Great Exhibition of 1851. Next, the children will get hands on and make their own inventions inspired by Victorian objects with product designer Jasleen Kaur. The day will end at 3pm and we are scheduled to arrive back in Leamington at 5.45pm for the children to be collected from school. I'm sure you'll agree; this will be a very exciting and memorable day for our children!

Your child will need to bring a packed lunch (in a disposable bag) and will be expected to wear full school uniform. They will be representing our school and may be photographed for a press-release and as such, are expected to be well dressed for the occasion! If your child is in receipt of a free school meal and would like us to order them one, please contact the school office.

If you give consent for your child to come on this trip, please fill in the attached forms granting your permission and return to school by **Monday 20th March**. You will find a 'Form OSA2' which will give us consent to take your child to the V&A museum in London and up to date medical information; given the trip extends beyond the normal school day, we will require this from all parents. The second form consents to your child having their photo taken by the V&A museum during the visit.
